Scholarships will be awarded by the KPFA board of directors. All applications must be postmarked or received prior to September 1st, 2014. Applications may be faxed, mailed, emailed or returned in person to the KPFA office. All scholarship funds will be released to selected recipients upon receipt of post-secondary institution/trade/apprenticeship registration confirmation for the 2014 year.
